Dear Holy Trinity Family,

September 4th is the launch of our Fall schedule and this includes Catechism class. Traditionally, Catechism is meant for persons seeking Confirmation by the Bishop, however, Catechism is useful for all Christians no matter the age, as the point of catechesis is to train Christians in the **fundamentals** of the Faith. Similarly, even the best athletes regularly train in the fundamentals of their own sport. Whether it's your first time or tenth time in Catechism class, you may well benefit by attending. The Book of Common Prayer divides these fundamentals of the Faith into three categories: worship, doctrine, and the Christian life. Between September 4th and December 18th we'll examine each of these categories by deeply studying the Lord's Prayer, the Apostle's Creed, and the Ten Commandments. Through our study we will discuss who God is, His plan and purpose for mankind, salvation, the Church, Holy Scripture, and everything else that a well-informed and grounded Christian ought to know. Although these classes will be tailored for High School aged students, we encourage everyone to make Catechism class a priority on Sunday nights.

Catechism will last 1.5 hours each Sunday night from 6:00pm-7:30pm. We will begin in the Sanctuary with prayer and then move to the Parish Hall for dinner, instruction, and discussion.

While an RSVP is **not required** to attend, it is certainly **preferred** as it will help us plan with greater precision.

If you are interested in *volunteering* to help with Catechism - thank you!
