The bishop also appointed Fr. Brad to be the liaison for the Board's work in Haiti. Fr. Brad will leave for Cap Haitian, Haiti, tomorrow (returning Friday) on a trip to meet our Haitian ministry partners and to assess the ministry's status and potential. The APA currently supports a mission parish, a school, and a poultry farm in Cap Haitian, Haiti.
