## Good Friday Stations of the Cross

Please join us for our Stations of the Cross Liturgy. Our new service is based on the Liturgy of St. Alphonsus Ligouri (one of the "Doctors of the Church") and features the ancient 6th century hymn "Pange Lingua" (#66 in the Hymnal), as translated by the noted priest Fr. John Mason Neale. Please plan to participate in this moving and powerful service, walking with Jesus through his passion, crucifixion, death and burial. Following this service, it is customary to depart in silence and maintain silence in the sanctuary until Easter morning.

## Blessing of the Easter Eggs at 8:00 AM, April 20

Easter eggs of any color (but especially red) will be blessed at the first service of Easter. Please bring your eggs (bring 1 egg or dozens) to the first service for blessing. Then keep the eggs for yourself, share them with your children or grandchildren, or distribute them to your friends and neighbors. Be sure to tell them the story of why eggs are blessed on Easter!
