Lectio Divina (Divine Reading)

In the middle ages, St. Benedict taught his monks to read the Scriptures as prayer, and to pray their way through the Scriptures on a regular basis. To encourage this practice, St. Benedict assigned daily Psalm and Scripture readings for his monasteries. These readings were read aloud at prayer times and during meals so that monks could "pray the scriptures without ceasing." Our Book of Common Prayer, which is a guide for Benedictine Spirituality, calls each of us to be actively reading and praying the Scriptures on a daily basis. To help facilitate this practice, we will publish the Lectionary (the appointed Lectio Divina readings) for each day of the following week. These assignments are taken from the 1928 BCP and are different from the REC BCP as found in our pew edition. Both Lectionaries are acceptable. Use whichever you prefer. This published listing is for your convenience or for those who wish to be on the "same page" as the Rector of the parish.
