- Wed - Psalm 17; 2 Samuel 15:1-12; 2 Corinthians 3 / Psalm 18:1-20; Ecclesiasticus\* 4:20-5:7; Matthew 2:13-end
- Thur - Psalm 25; 2 Samuel 15:13-29; 2 Corinthians 4 / Psalm 27; Ecclesiasticus\* 15:11-end; Matthew 3
- Fri - Psalm 32; 2 Samuel 15:30-16:4; 2 Corinthians 5:1-10 / Psalm 22; Ecclesiasticus\* 16:17-end; Matthew 4:1-11
- Sat - Psalm 31; 2 Samuel 16:5-19; 2 Corinthians 5:11-end / Psalm 29, 30; Ecclesiasticus\* 19:4-18; Matthew 4:12-end

*\* Ecclesiasticus is often titled Sirach in newer translations of the Bible.*
