Lectio Divina (Divine Reading) - Trinity Fourteen

1928 Book of Common Prayer Lectionary readings for Morning and Evening Prayer in the week following St. Matthew, Apostle and Evangelist (14th Sunday After Trinity):

- Thur - Psalm 56; 2 Samuel 18:19-end; 2 Corinthians 8:1-15 / Psalm 66; Ecclesiasticus* 28:13-end; Matthew 5:38-end
- Fri - Psalm 69; 2 Samuel 19:1-10; 2 Corinthians 8:16-end / Psalm 51; Ecclesiasticus* 31:12-32:2; Matthew 6:1-18
- Sat - Psalm 68; 2 Samuel 19:11-23; 2 Corinthians 9 / Psalm 67, 93; Ecclesiasticus* 34:1-8; Matthew 6:19-end

* Ecclesiasticus is often titled Sirach in newer translations of the Bible.
