We will begin construction on the Parking Lot on Monday morning. The parking lot will be closed for at least one week.

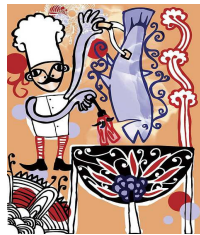
Accordingly, there will be no mid-week Eucharist on Wednesday.
