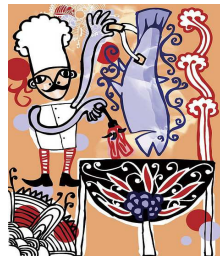
Friday Night Out - Spaghetti Dinner
