Anyone wishing to receive a prayer and blessing will be invited to the Altar. Participation is not compulsory, but all, including visitors, are welcome.

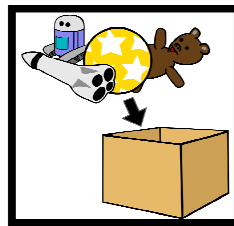
Micah's Place Toy Drive... through December 7th
