The Feast of the Epiphany of Our Lord Jesus Christ is one of the oldest Christian feasts. *Epiphany* comes from a Greek verb meaning "to reveal," and it commemorates the first two occasions on which Jesus' divinity, according to Christian belief, was manifested: when the three kings (also known as wise men or Magi) visited infant Jesus in Bethlehem, and when John the Baptist baptized him in the River Jordan.

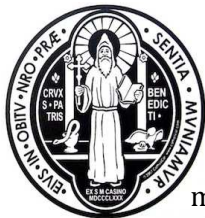
