Attendance is open to everyone and members of the parish are asked to vote for vestry representatives as well as delegates to Diocesan Synod and to give approval to the 2016 budget. 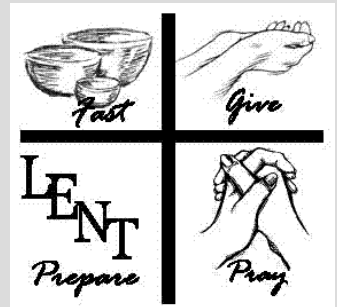
