## Annual Parish Meeting - Sunday, February 28th at 9:15 PM

The Annual Parish Meeting will be held on the last Sunday of this month, February 28, in Scott King Hall. The meeting will take place during the Sunday Bible College hour from 9:15-10:15 AM. Attendance is open to everyone and members of the parish are asked to vote for vestry representatives as well as delegates to Diocesan Synod and to give approval to the 2016 budget. Please plan to attend this important meeting.

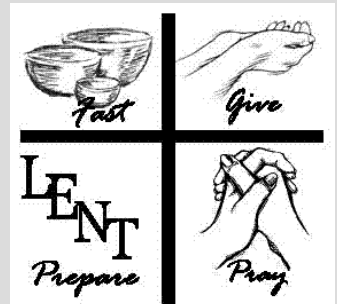
