Parish Representatives needed to attend Synod

A Joint Anglican Synod is planned for October 4-6, 2017, in Atlanta, Georgia. This historic synod will draw together four different Anglican jurisdictions: The Anglican Catholic Church, the Anglican Church in America, the Diocese of the Holy Cross, and our own Anglican Province of America. The event will culminate in a signing of an Intercommunion Concordat between the jurisdictions. Holy Trinity Church is allowed two lay representatives to this Synod. It will be a very busy time conducting business for the Diocese and the Province, while also fellowshiping with members of the three other jurisdictions. If you would like to represent our parish at this synod, please submit your name to the parish office for consideration. Nominees will be chosen in a special election to be held in the next few weeks.
