Annual Parish Feast Review

On Trinity Sunday, June 11, we celebrated the 11th anniversary of the founding of the Parish. It was a glorious day. Bishop Walter preached and celebrated the Mass for the largest crowd we have ever had for a non-holiday service. During the Sunday Bible College hour we hosted a guest speaker, Dr. Kevin Clark, who spoke about Classical Christian Education. I was thrilled to see many visitors from the community. In fact, we had to move the Sunday Bible College class to the Chapel to accommodate the crowd. In the second Mass, we had a number of families with children, all of whom came to visit us because of our sustained effort to reach out to our community by educating children with a Classical Christian Education, without regard to their ability to pay. I am overjoyed to report that we now have 42 students enrolled (which is our full capacity) from over 30 families which are not members of our parish. They come from all over our Island, Yulee, Callaghan, and even Kingsland. Several of these children are on scholarship, thanks to the generosity of our parishioners. (On Thursday morning I met with the architects and builders in preparation for building a new school campus where we will teach children from all walks of life and from all across our area about Christ and his Gospel.) These are very exciting times for Holy Trinity Church. I can't thank you all enough for responding to this opportunity with generosity, support, and sustained effort, serving God's vision in so many different ways. HTAC's parishioners are touching the lives of many who really need Christ. God is at work here. Of course, the Feast Day was capped by our Picnic in the Parish Hall, with well over 100 people sharing shrimp and fellowship. Shrimp is good! St. Paul signed many of his letters with such things as, "I thank my God upon every remembrance of you." I know what he meant. I'm so thankful I get to be your Rector in our wonderful parish. ~ Fr.
