## B.E.L.L.S - Marks of a Mission Minded Parish (From Last Week's Sunday Bible College)

Last week we watched a video presentation by Bishop Ray Sutton on the topic of becoming a missions / minded parish. He noted that the highly successful Celtic missionaries built communities that were marked by the following characteristics:

- B** = Blessings to unbelievers – a mission minded parish looks for ways to bless non-believers
- E** = Eating with unbelievers – mission minded parishes share meals with unbelievers, and invite them to experience the “habits” of Christians
- L** = Listening to the world – a mission minded parish listens to the culture of the world around it and learns to answer the needs and questions for which unbelievers are seeking
- L** = Learning Community – a mission minded parish is an indefatigable center of learning for all people: Catechesis, Scripture, schools, seminary: The parish is a place of great learning.
- S** = Sending – a missional parish equips Christians and then sends them into the world to plant new parishes to spread the Christian life throughout the world.
