Pre-Lent Begins with Septuagesima Next Sunday

Next Sunday, January 28, marks 70 days till Easter. This Sunday is known in the Church as Septuagesima (meaning 70 days). It also marks the beginning of a three week season of preparation for the disciplines of Lent.
