Vicar General David Haines+ Elected Missionary Bishop

The Standing Committees of the Province and the Dioceses have created a missionary jurisdiction and have elected and consented to Episcopal Orders for Fr. Haines. The Bishop-elect has served the Foreign Missions Board of the Anglican Province of America for several years and has earned an outstanding reputation for his work with our mission partners around the world. He was elected to serve as bishop for our work in Haiti and in Ecuador but will continue his work with our other partners in India and the Philippines as well. God bless Bishop-Elect Haines as he prepares for this new ministry. He is scheduled for Consecration at the 2018 Synod in July. (FYI, Fr. Cunningham serves on both Standing Committees and is a member of the Foreign Missions Board.)
