The Third Sunday In Lent

- Mon** Ezra 9-10; Psalm 7 ~ When the Persian Empire overthrew the Babylonian Empire in 539 BC, many Hebrew captives were allowed to return to Jerusalem. Then, in 458 BC, Ezra led a second "wave" of exiles to return to Jerusalem. Esther, though Hebrew, was chosen Queen by the Persian King Xerxes and her tenure was a decisive turning point that allowed these second and third waves to occur. The Jewish festival of Purim celebrates the events of this book.

- Wed** Esther 3-4; Psalm 17
- Thu** Esther 5-6; Psalm 37
- Fri** Esther 7-8; Psalm 46
- Sat** Esther 9-10; Psalm 49 ~ In 445 BC Nehemiah led the third and final wave of returning exiles in a charge to rebuild the walls of Jerusalem.
- Sun** Nehemiah 1-2; Psalm 93
