Fri Nehemiah 12-13; Psalm 111 ~ Approximately one hundred years after the return of the exiled under Nehemiah's leadership, Alexander the Great conquered Palestine and added it to his empire. After more than a century under the radical Hellenization of the Hebrew people, a faithful family known as the Maccabees led a revolt which led to the restoration of worship among the people. The Jewish festival of Hanukkah celebrates this event.
