NEW MINISTRY OPPORTUNITY BEGINS

Holy Trinity is announcing a new ministry opportunity which will meet for four weeks in August 2019. The *St. John the Apostle Lay Visitation Ministry* program will begin with classes to learn the fundamentals for involvement in this ministry. *Pastoral Care in Hospitals* by Neville A. Kirkwood (2nd Edition) will be the text for the program. Volunteers will focus on learning skills to become the hands and feet of Christ for those in need in our community and church family. The Lay Visitors will meet one time per month following their training to continue learning and fine tuning their expertise. Sign-up sheets are available on the table as you enter Scott-King Hall as well as on the credenza in the narthex. The dates and times of the meetings will be determined by those attending.

Mary Kay Young, LMHC (Licensed Mental Health Counselor) will be the teacher/facilitator for this program. Licensed by the State of Florida for the past 28 years, she has long-term experience with all ages as a psychotherapist for individuals and groups in the areas of grief, homicide, suicide, divorce, depression, anxiety, trauma, bi-polar disorder, behavioral and school-based issues. She holds a BS and an MEd in Guidance and Counseling. Mary Kay is trained in cognitive-behavioral therapy, trauma-focused therapy, as well as EMDR (Eye Movement Desensitization and Reprocessing).
