St. John's Lay Visitation Ministry Training Begins This Friday

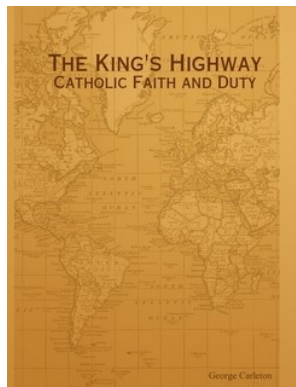
