## Farewell Brunch for Jane Turner, Sunday, September 8<sup>th</sup> at 9:15 AM

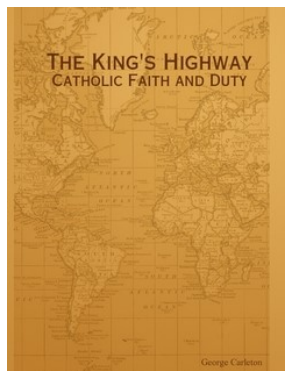
