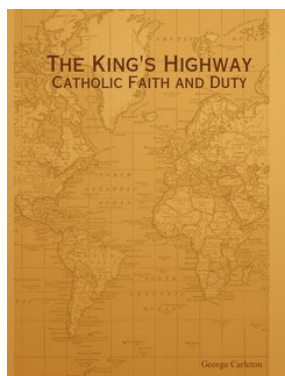
## Birthday and Anniversary Blessings
