On the First Sunday in Advent the scene is empty, with only the animals and the shepherd present in the stable. Each week, the scene will grow as Mary and Joseph find their way to Bethlehem. On Christmas Eve the baby Jesus will appear in the manger. The Creche will not be complete until the Sunday of Epiphany when the three wise men arrive from afar. Look around the Chapel to track the wise men on their long journey.
