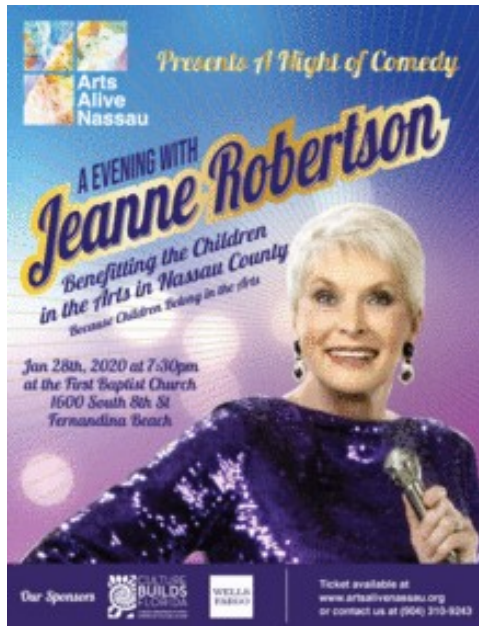
An Evening of Laughter & Fellowship w/ Jeanne Robertson on Tuesday, January 28th at 7:30 PM
