## February First Friday Fellowship: "Favorite Recipe From Mom"

February's fellowship falls in the week of the Feast of the Purification of St. Mary the Virgin, celebrating God's gift of a child to St. Mary. To honor the sacred motherhood of the Virgin Mary, we invite all who desire to bring their own favorite dish from your mother's cook book or perhaps the favorite dish you made for your own children.

## February 2 is Candlemas

Today marks 40 days since the Nativity of our Lord. According to the Mosaic Law, after giving birth to a son the mother was to wait forty days (resting and bonding with her new child) and then present herself and her son to the priest. She would then be blessed and received back into the precincts of worship. Her son would be given to God and then redeemed through the offering of a sacrifice. When St. Mary the Virgin presented her Son Jesus, He was acknowledged as the "Light to lighten the gentiles." Since the second or third century, churches have celebrated these two events by blessing candles to be used in Mass throughout the year because they are sacramental symbols of that Light, Jesus Christ. Worshipers are invited to bring beeswax candles to the Candlemas for blessing so that you may have hallowed candles for your home. **Happy Candlemas!**

**6:00 PM** - Holy Communion with Imposition of Ashes

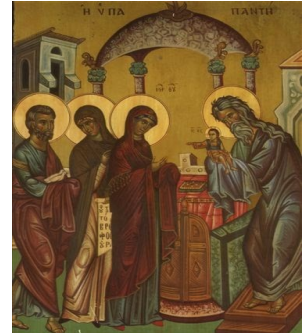
## Announcing a Lenten 'Fast' Support Group!
