### The House Of Bishops Cancels Public Worship

Received Friday, March 20th

"To all APA Clergy from the House of Bishops,

"... in consultation... your APA Bishops have agreed that... for the safety and protection of both our parishioners and our Clergy, all forms of in-person worship must be suspended for the next two weeks. After that time, we will re-evaluate where we are in light of the CDC and Government recommendations." Read the rest of the statement on our parish website.

### The Order for Spiritual Communion

While the order to suspend Christian worship is unprecedented in our lifetimes, the Church in her long history has faced this before. For this reason, the Church has provided the Order for Spiritual Communion, a private devotion for the faithful who desire to receive Jesus in the Sacrament but are prevented by circumstances beyond their control. For as long as we are required to forgo meeting together, our services will be live-streamed through Facebook and YouTube. During the time when the faithful would normally receive the Sacrament, one of the priests of our parish will lead us in praying that Order for Spiritual Communion. A PDF file of the devotions is available for download on our parish website so that every faithful Christian may pray along. Until this crisis ends, I encourage all Christians to make use of these devotions provided for our soul's health.

### **Worship Opportunities in this Extraordinary Time**

**Sunday Mass** will be celebrated privately by the parish priests and livestreamed at 8:00 AM on Sunday Morning until public worship is restored. The recording of this Service will be made available for those who can not join us at that early hour.

Wednesday Mass will be live-streamed through Facebook at 12:15 PM.

**Friday Stations of the Cross** will be live-streamed through Facebook at 9:30 AM Each Friday. This is a change in time for the live-stream, made to facilitate the online class schedule of Lindisfarne Hall.

**Bible Study on Colossians by Fr. Brian Oldfield!** Fr. Oldfield is posting daily lessons on Colossians to his YouTube channel. Each video is approximately 10 minutes long and offers an opportunity to remain immersed in the Word of God even when isolated.
