## UPDATE: Mass Attendance Guidelines Change Next Sunday, JUNE 14

On Sunday, June 14<sup>th</sup>, our procedures and guidelines for public worship will change in accordance with updates on the state of the coronavirus and COVID-19 outbreak. Below are the important changes which will effect you and your participation in Mass.

1. We will celebrate two Masses at the normal times, 8:00 AM and 10:30 AM. Following guidelines for restaurants, we will open 50% of our seating, which should allow us to accommodate worshipers in two services while maintaining appropriate space for social distancing practices.
2. Reservations are no longer required. Simply attend the Mass of your choice. There should be plenty of room with the increased availability of seating.
3. For the foreseeable future, the Sacrament will be distributed by intinction directly on the tongue with the priest cleansing his fingers between each communicant. Please continue to receive standing at the altar rail.
4. For the immediate future, we will continue the following practices:
  - No singing of hymns or service music
  - No shaking of hands, hugging or "holy kisses"
  - Bring your own Book of Common Prayer and Bible
  - Sunday Mass and Sunday Bible College classes are available online through the summer months
  - Wednesday Mass is now open to the public and will no longer be available online
