On The Tenth Day of Christmas...

Did you know the Christmas season is 12 days long, beginning with The Nativity on December 25th and ending with The Epiphany on January 6th. Thus, this First Sunday after Christmas is only the Third Day of Christmas. For Christians Christmas is just getting started. So, keep those Christmas trees decorated, the lights on and the parties going. There are two more days left to celebrate the birth of Christ.

The Christmas Creche on the Altar

From Advent till Epiphany, the Altar features a Creche or Manger Scene. On the First Sunday in Advent the Creche is empty, with only the animals and the shepherd present in the stable. Each week, the scene grows. On Christmas Eve the baby Jesus appears in the manger. The Creche will not be complete until the Feast of the Epiphany (January 6th) when the three wise men arrive.
