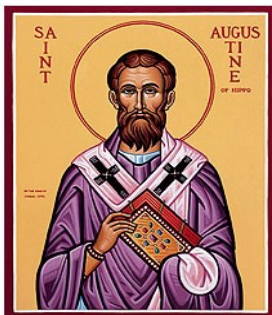
Altar Flowers

Wednesday Feast Day: St. Augustine of Hippo (386 A.D.)



Saint Augustine, was a theologian, philosopher, and the bishop of Hippo in Roman North Africa. His writings influenced the development of Western philosophy and Western Christianity, and he is viewed as one of the most important Church Fathers of the Latin Church in the Patristic Period. His many important works include *The City of God*, *On Christian Doctrine*, and *Confessions*. Augustine is recognized as a saint in the Catholic Church, the Eastern Orthodox Church, and the Anglican Communion. He is also a preeminent Catholic Doctor of the Church and the patron of Augustinian Monks.
