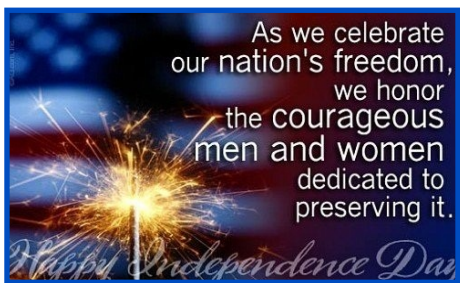
2021 HTAC and Lindisfarne Hall Youth Mission to Melbourne
