We will provide a booklet with the Latin and the English translation and the ceremony will follow the ancient Latin ritual of the Sarum Rite (the basis of the Anglican BCP). Please plan to join us for this momentous occasion and invite your friends, especially your Traditional Catholic, Orthodox and serious minded friends who might profit from a traditional Mass. May God bless our desire to be faithful to his gifts!
