The Second Sunday in Advent is known the world over as Bible Sunday because of the collect in our Book of Common Prayer. To celebrate, please bring your favorite Bible to Mass this Sunday and have your Bible blessed as part of our worship.

During Advent, the Altar flowers are replaced with the Creche scene. On the First Sunday in Advent the scene is empty, with only the animals and the shepherd present in the stable. Each week, the scene will grow as Mary and Joseph find their way to Bethlehem. On Christmas Eve the baby Jesus will appear in the manger. The Creche will not be complete until the Sunday of Epiphany when the three wise men arrive from afar. Look around the chapel to track the wise men on their long journey.
