What's In A Name: LINDISFARNE HALL

Our parish school is named after a famous island in Northern England near the east-coast border with Scotland. **Lindisfarne Island** became famous in the 7th century when the King of Northumbria invited a monk named Aiden to bring Christianity from the Monastery of Iona to his kingdom. Aiden established a Monastery on **Lindisfarne** complete with an Abbey and a school. He invited the people of Northumbria to send their children to **Lindisfarne** where Aiden educated the children using Sacred Scripture and the Celtic Traditions of the Church. Their educations complete, with Christ in their hearts and the Gospel in their minds, the students returned to their villages and evangelized their families and friends. Aiden was so successful in his evangelization of Northumbria (northern England and southern Scotland) that by the 12th century the Romans Christened **Lindisfarne** "The Holy Isle."

We named our school **Lindisfarne Hall** with a conscientious desire to model our ministry in north Florida and southern Georgia on **Lindisfarne's** success. We invite all people to send their children here where we offer an excellent education, in hopes that many will receive Christ in their hearts and ensconce the Gospel in their minds, returning home to evangelize their families and friends. Our dream is that someday Amelia Island will be known as the "Holy Isle of Florida."

Interesting aside, the word **Lindisfarne** is Gaelic meaning "sea island with a fresh water pond." Our parish and school are located on an island in the Atlantic and situated next to a fresh water pond.

Our patron saints at **Lindisfarne Hall** are the two greatest saints from **Lindisfarne Abbey** - St. Aiden and St. Cuthbert. St. Aiden's feast day is this Wednesday, August 31st and will be celebrated with a special Mass at 10:00 AM. All are invited.
