There was a time when, on "Stir Up Sunday," families would gather together after Mass to stir up the figgy pudding for Christmas (Christmas puddings must be prepared weeks before Christmas to allow them to "mature"). More recently, this Sunday is a reminder to begin stirring up confectionary creations and savory casseroles for the Thanksgiving feast. Whichever tradition you hold, this is an exciting time of year, when we pray that God will stir us up, and make us his own special creation, with the "sweet smelling savor" of Christ Jesus.
