Gaudete "Rose" Sunday - Rejoice in the Lord Always!

Today is called Gaudete Sunday from the first word spoken in the ancient liturgy, Gaudete - Rejoice! Liturgically, this day is marked by the color of a rose to symbolize the lessening of the Advent rigours. Three roses are placed on the Altar to mark this day. The roses on the Altar this Rose Sunday are given by Linda Piotrowski and Harrison Neal in loving memory of Don Neal, and to the glory of the most Holy Trinity.

The Altar Creche of Advent
