## *The Nativity of our Lord*

### **St. Francis and the Altar Creche**

During Advent, the Altar features a Creche or Manger Scene. On the First Sunday in Advent the Creche is empty, with only the animals and the shepherd present in the stable. Each week, the scene will grow until, on Christmas Eve the infant Jesus appears in the manger. The Creche will not be complete until the Feast of the Epiphany (January 6<sup>th</sup>) when the three wise men arrive. This tradition honors St. Francis of Assisi who created the first recorded Christmas manger scene outside Israel in order to evangelize the people of Italy.

## **The Twelve Days of Christmas**

### **The Feast of the Holy Innocents, Wednesday, December 28<sup>th</sup>**

This feast commemorates the holy children martyred by Herod in his attempt to kill Jesus. It is also the occasion when we commemorate all the innocent children whose lives were ended in their mother's wombs through abortion (*in the U.S. 1973 - 2020, ~ 63.6 million children aborted; in Florida, 27% of all pregnancies end in deliberate abortion; with a glimmer of hope, Nassau county reported 118 abortions last year, much lower than other counties in the state, indicating a greater respect for life*). Please join us in praying that we will love and protect life.

### **The Feast of the Circumcision of Christ - Sunday January 1<sup>st</sup>**

Sunday, January 1<sup>st</sup>, we will celebrate the Circumcision of Christ at both Masses (8:00 AM and 10:30 AM)

### **First Friday Fellowship on The Epiphany - January 6<sup>th</sup>**

The 12 Days of Christmas Ends on January 5<sup>th</sup>, followed on January 6<sup>th</sup> by the Feast of the Epiphany. This Feast commemorates the arrival of the Magi to visit the infant Christ, which represents the first time that Jesus was revealed to the Gentiles. It is our tradition at HTC to serve our favorite New Year's foods (Hoppin John, pork, peas, greens, cornbread, or whatever your family considers a New Year's favorite. After the Feast, we will celebrate with a King Cake and the crowning of the new parish monarch for A.D. 2023.
