## Anglican Catechism Moment: St. John's Book of Signs

Today's Gospel reading is among the most well known for Christians and non-Christians alike. Taken from St. John's Gospel, The Wedding at Cana is the first of many "signs" recounted in the first half of the book. For John, "these signs were not just mighty works, but miracles that unveil the glory and power of God working through Christ." (ICSB p. 165) To get the most out of this story, we must look beyond the miracle of the wine to identify the glory revealed by the water made wine.
