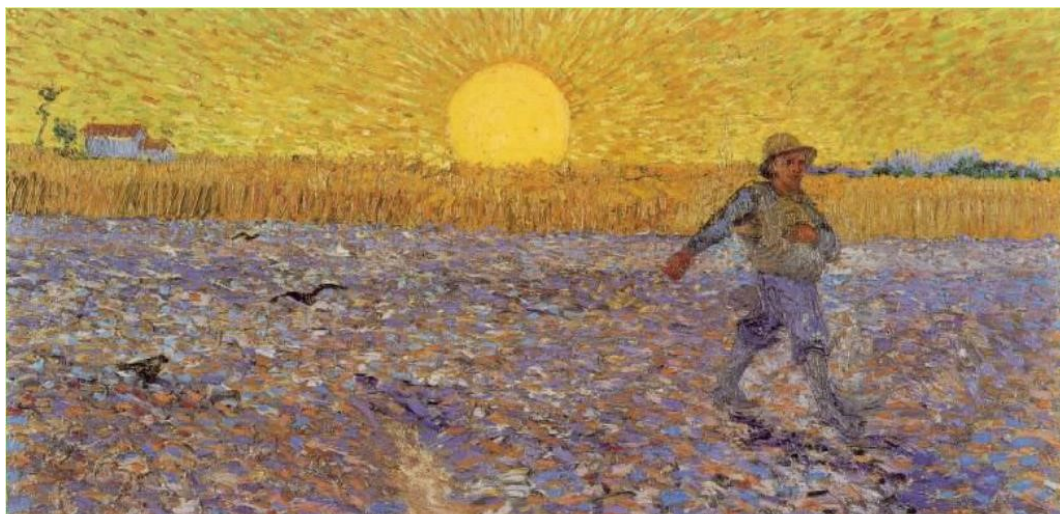

The Parable of the Sower and the Four Soils - From Today's Gospel Reading

Sexagesima Sunday

Pre-Lent trivia: Next Sunday is known as Quinquagesima (Latin for 50th) because next Sunday is exactly 50 days before Resurrection Sunday. Extrapolating backward from there, this Sunday is called Sexagesima (60th, though it is really only 57 days) and last week was called Septuagesima (70th, though it was, in fact, only 64 days). Though these names sound impressive, they are only approximations - however, these names have lasted for at least 1,300 years, not because they are "accurate" but because these names mark the "Gesima" weeks as three weeks set apart for making preparations for the Lenten Fast and disciplines.
