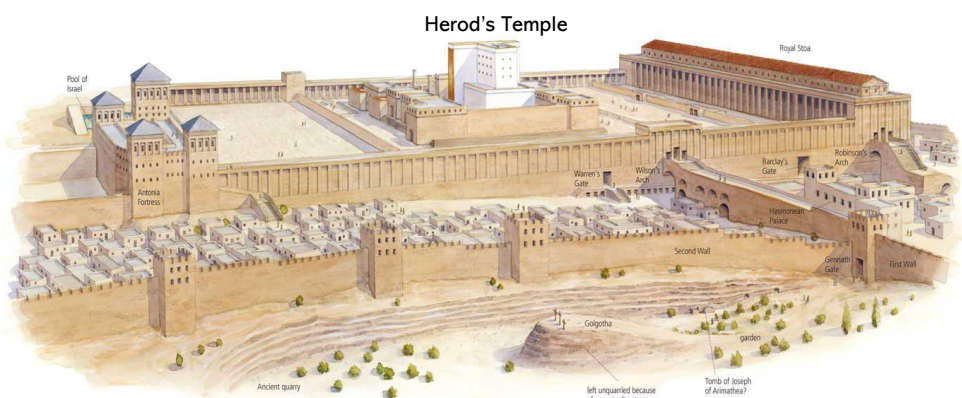

## The Sunday Next Before Lent &... The Liturgy

The Season of Lent is marked by several specific Liturgical practices which are distinct from the rest of the year. Below are some of the more important changes coming in the next week. We encourage you to spend time looking over the prayers in the Book of Common Prayer in preparation for a Holy Lent.

### This Sunday

- The Burial of the Alleluias (We will not say the "A" word during Lent)
- Gloria in Excelsis is not sung until the Resurrection Celebration

### Ash Wednesday

- A Penitential Office, BCP 60-63 and Imposition of Ashes

### Next Sunday

- Barren Branches (a.k.a. Holy Sticks) on the Altar
- The Decalogue (Ten Commandments), BCP 68
- Longer Version of the Invitation to Confession, BCP 85
- The Shorter version of The Lord's Prayer, BCP 58
- The Aaronic Blessing, BCP 63

## Fasting During Lent

Here are some important considerations for those new to fasting:

- The Lenten Fast typically means refraining from all meat, sugar and processed foods for 40 days and 40 nights beginning Ash Wednesday and continuing to Resurrection Sunday (Easter). Also, traditionally, only one small meal in keeping with the fast is consumed in the evening.
- However, the Lenten Fast is guided by grace and mercy. Therefore, those who suffer from diet allergies such as celiac disease may adjust their fast accordingly. Diabetics may need to fast from different foods. If you have questions, contact your priest and he will help you design an appropriate fast.
- Exemptions from fasting are granted to very young children (and the mothers who feed them), those very advanced in age, those suffering illnesses which prevent fasting, and workers engaged in very strenuous physical labor.
