The First Sunday in Lent &... The Liturgy

The Season of Lent is marked by several specific Liturgical practices which are distinct from the rest of the year. Below are some of the more important changes made to today's Liturgy. We encourage you to spend time looking over the prayers in the Book of Common Prayer in preparation for a Holy Lent.

The First Sunday in Lent

- Barren Branches (a.k.a. Holy Sticks) on the Altar
- The Decalogue (Ten Commandments), BCP 68
- Longer Version of the Invitation to Confession, BCP 85
- The Shorter version of The Lord's Prayer, BCP 58
- The Aaronic Blessing, BCP 63

Fasting During Lent

Here are some important considerations for those new to fasting:

- The Lenten Fast typically means refraining from all meat, sugar, and processed food products for 40 days beginning Ash Wednesday and continuing to Resurrection Sunday (Easter). Traditionally, only one small meal in keeping with the fast is consumed in the evening.
- However, the Lenten Fast is guided by grace and mercy. Therefore, those who suffer certain conditions such as celiac disease or diabetes may adjust their fast accordingly. If you have questions, contact your priest and he will help you design an appropriate fast.
- Exemptions from fasting are granted to very young children & their mothers, the advanced in age, those suffering illness, and physical laborers.
