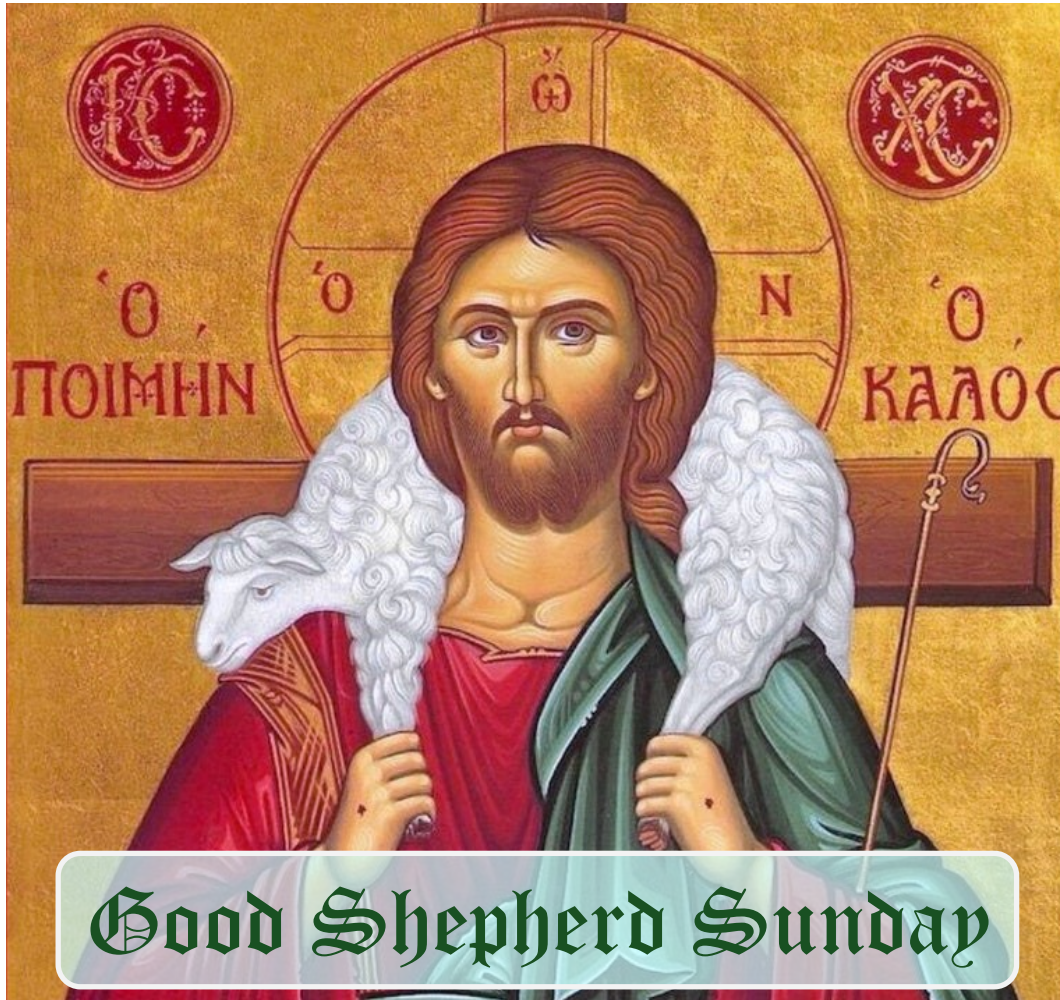

Throughout Eastertide (beginning Resurrection Sunday and continuing through Whitsunday / Pentecost) we will use a form of the Liturgy based on the ancient Sarum Rite of the Anglican Tradition. This special Liturgy is provided in a worship booklet available when you enter the chapel.
