Anglican Moment: What is Rogation Sunday?

Today has been called Rogation Sunday for many centuries because the next three days (Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday) are the Minor Rogation Days of the Church year. These days take their name from the Latin word rogare meaning to ask. These three Rogation Days were traditionally held as days of fasting and abstinence with processions of the faithful through the fields. What were they asking? For God to bless the seeds in the fields to grow into a bountiful harvest. In later times, it became customary for parishioners to bring packets of seeds or bags of soil from their field to be blessed on Rogation Sunday, in case the priest couldn't make a procession to every farm. In modern times, when most of us depend on others to grow our food, it is customary to pray for farmers and ranchers to prosper in their harvest for our sakes.
