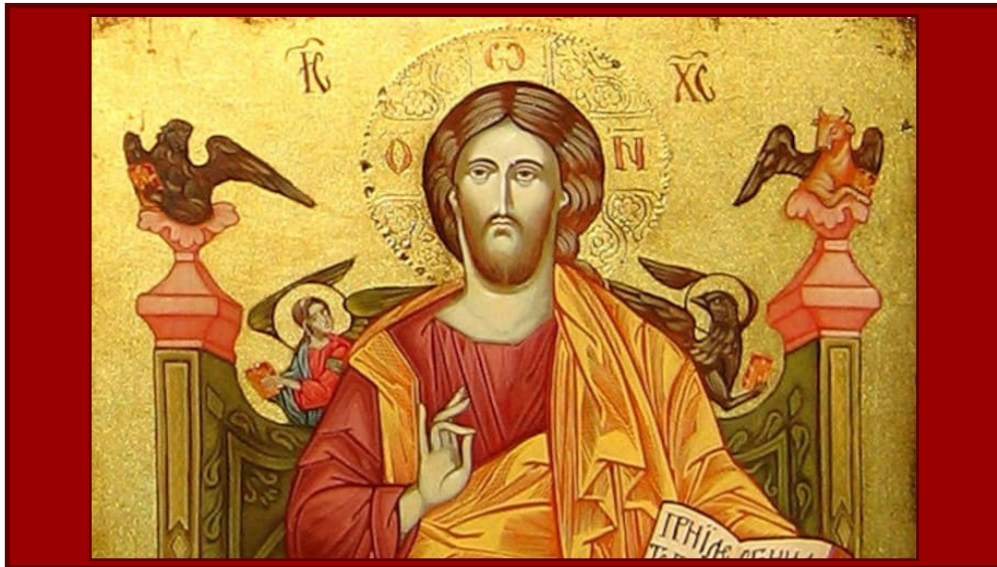

This Week Sunday Bible College: The Sunday Propers

For the last time before summer, join Fr. Peter Joslyn in a discussion of the Sunday Propers (see sidebar for this Sunday's Propers). The Sunday Propers are the Scripture readings appointed for the Sunday feast day.

Summer Schedule for HTC begins Next Sunday

During the summer at Holy Trinity Church we have a more relaxed schedule. The Vestry will not hold a regular meeting until September, and Sunday Bible College addresses a different subject each week.

Next Sunday, Wear Red for Whitsunday (aka Pentecost)!

Next Sunday is the Feast of Whitsunday, the celebration of the gift of the Holy Ghost, sent by Jesus Christ to fill his holy Church. In the Church's Tradition, red is the color of the Holy Ghost. We invite everyone to celebrate this great festival by wearing something red - red dress, red shoes, red pants, red socks, red shoes. Scarves, hats, ties belts, **anything red**.

Where is the Paschal Candle?

The Paschal Candle, also called the Christ Candle, first appears at the Easter Vigil (the night before Easter). It stands on the pavement near the Altar and burns continuously throughout Easter as a sign of the unquenchable life of Christ's Resurrection. However, on Ascension Day (40 days after Easter), at the reading of the Gospel, the Paschal Candle is moved to the Baptismal Font. From this point forward, it will only be lighted during Baptisms. Why Baptisms? When Jesus ascended into heaven, he gave us the Great Commandment (St. Matthew 28:18-20), in which he promised to be with us as we went forth to make Disciples by Baptizing them. We light the Paschal Candle at Baptisms to show that Christ is still with us, even to the end of the age.
