The Gloria In Excelsis: Praise or Penance?

The question of the nature of the Gloria is a raging debate among scholars of the Liturgy: Is the Gloria a song of praise or is it penitential in nature? The answer to that question determines where it is most appropriately placed within the Liturgy. If it is Penitential, it should be sung before the Confession and Absolution. If it is praise, it should be sung after receiving Communion in praise to God's grace. The debate hinges on the following:

1. The Canticle opens with an unqualified song of praise sung by the lips of Angels.
2. It then proceeds into a three-fold plea to Christ for mercy.
3. The Gloria ends with a confession of the Holy Trinity.

On this evidence alone, the Gloria could be considered either praise or penance. However, there is more to consider. The penitential portion of the Gloria is a greater percentage of the song. What's more, for 1,500 years the Church considered it penitential. Not until the Reformation was it considered a hymn of praise and moved to the end of the Mass. On this evidence, the Gloria is more penitential than praise, and is usually returned to its original position near the beginning of the Mass.
