Dead Words and False Friends, Part 1

The King James Version of the Bible is a classic without peer. Published in 1611, it still reigns supreme and is the primary text of Holy Scripture in Anglican liturgy. However, in the past 412 years, the English language has changed. Some words from 1611 have fallen completely out of use: these are called dead words. Other 1611 words are still in use yet have changed in meaning: these words sound familiar, they trick us into thinking we understand the original meaning when we do not. These words are called false friends. Join us as we discover some of these dead words and false friends in the King James Bible (and the Book of Common Prayer).
