Please bring your old palm crosses to church any time between now and February 11th. We will burn them in a special ceremony in order to make the holy ashes for Ash Wednesday. The ceremony will commence at 10:15 AM on Shrove Tuesday. All are invited.

How To Celebrate Pre-Lent / The Three Gesima Sundays

Septuagesima is the first of the three gesimas, including Sexagesima and Quinquagesima. The gesimas are a preparatory season before Ash Wednesday. Here are three ways to observe these Sundays in preparation for a Holy Lent.

1. **Wear something purple.** Especially on Septuagesima (January 28th). Purple is the liturgical color of the season and wearing it helps us get into the mindset of the season.
2. **Begin a reading of Genesis.** During the Seasons of Pre-Lent and Lent, it is customary to read through the book of Genesis followed by Exodus. Considering the current crisis in Israel and the rest of the Middle East, reading these two books is a very appropriate spiritual act for this year.
3. **Prep for the Lenten Fast.** Gather your favorite vegetarian recipes and find a few new ones you would like to try. At the same time, treat yourself to all the meat in your refrigerator, so that on Ash Wednesday, there are no temptations awaiting you back home in the Frigidaire.
4. **Eat Pancakes!** Join us for Shrove Tuesday Pancake Supper, February 13th.
