## Altar Flowers

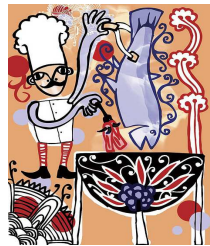
The Altar flowers are given to the Glory of God by James Bunch in loving celebration and thanksgiving of his son, Jimmy's birthday (April 26).
