Family Night Spaghetti Dinner, May 15th at 6:00 PM

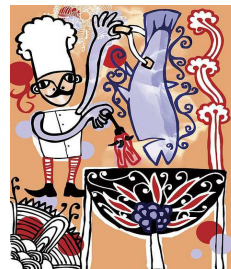

1928 Book of Common Prayer Lectionary readings for Morning and Evening Prayer in the week following Rogation Sunday (Morning / Evening):

- Wed - Psalm 144; Jeremiah 14:1-9; 1 John 5:5-15 / Psalm 93; *Song of the Three Children***; Luke 24:44-end
- Thur* - Psalm 96; Daniel 7:9-14; Ephesians 4:1-16 / Psalm 24; Isaiah 33:5-22; Hebrews 4:14-5:10
- Fri - Psalm 15; Micah 4:1-7; Romans 8:31-end / Psalm 20; Isaiah 12; Acts 1:12-end
- Sat - Psalm 45; Genesis 49:1-10; 2 Thessalonians 2:13-end / Psalm 8; Jeremiah 23:5-8; Acts 2:1-21

** *The Song of the Three Children* is found in the Apocrypha. It can also be found in the BCP p. 12-14 / 1928 version p. 11-13. In both BCPs it is divided into two portions known as the Benedictus es, Domine and the Benedicite, omnia opera Domini. It comes from the book of Daniel, and is the song which three young men sang while they walked in the "fiery furnace."
