Diocesan Synod begins Tuesday

The annual meeting of the Diocese of the Eastern United States (APA) will be held this week at All Saints Anglican Church, Charlottesville, Virginia. Our parish will be represented by Fr. Cunningham, Mary Kay Young and Judy Constant. Alex Constant will also be present as a member of the Diocesan Standing Committee. In addition to the usual business and budget processes, there are two main decisions to be made at this meeting. The first is whether to accept or reject the mandatory age retirement of Bishop Walter Grundorf. (Our parish representatives will vote to deny him retirement and ask him to continue as our Bishop, which is his desire.) The Second main event will be to elect a new Suffragan Bishop to assist in the Diocese, especially in Florida. Fr. Brad Cunningham is one of three candidates in the election. Please pray for all our representatives and for Fr. Brad and the election.
